*Pope Francis's advocacy on inequality & the
climate emergency. Is it proper? Is it enough?*

Pope Francis has captured world attention for his incisive critiques of global poverty and inequality. His 2015 document, *Laudato Sí*, contrasted the Gospel imperative to care for the poor with the growing and extreme concentration of wealth globally, and he warned of the 'catastrophic' consequences of climate change. Is his advocacy working?
